The Bible brings things to light.

SCRIPTURE

*Your word is a lamp for my feet,
a light on my path (Psalm 119:105 NIV).*

GOAL OF SMALL GROUP

To help students understand that the Bible can make their life better.

THINK ABOUT THIS

Leaders—in this phase your students might not want to open up an actual book. Encourage your students to engage with Scripture in a way that works for them: on their phone, in your Group Text Bible Study, in an app, with verses on social media, etc.

Create meaningful conversation. Adjust the questions as needed, and don't feel like you need to answer all of them.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. When there's something you can't figure out when it comes to school, technology, social media, etc., what do you typically do? (Leaders—here are some options if no one's talking: Google it, YouTube search, ask a friend, keep trying and failing until you figure it out, quit and give up, etc.)
2. If you are looking for answers in the Bible, why is it so difficult to know where to look and what to look for?
3. What's one area of your life that you wish you could see more clearly than you do right now?
4. How could the Bible bring light to that area of your life? (Leaders—try talking about a time when something from the Bible helped bring something to light for you.)
5. Do you have access to a Bible? If so, do you have a version of the Bible you understand? (Leaders—your church may suggest a particular version of the Bible, which is great. We suggest the New International Version or the New Living Translation. Also, *The Message* can serve as a complementary resource.)
6. This week, we talked about the 10-10-10 plan: reading for 10 minutes, writing about it for 10 minutes, and talking about it for 10 minutes. How can you remind yourself to embrace this challenge this week?
7. What do you hope to get out of the Bible when you read it this week?
